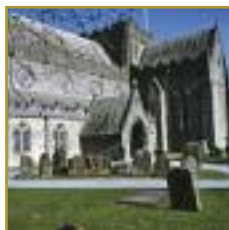

Experience Local Heritage & Culture

Kilkenny offers a unique selection of historical sites and buildings from the 7th century onwards, reflecting a tradition of monastic settlement and gracious living. Kilkenny City is recognised as the Medieval Capital of Ireland. The City is characterised by beautifully restored old buildings and winding slipways – however it is small and compact enough to explore on foot. The following gives you an overview of some of the many places to visit, please note most have a daily admission fee and set periods of opening times however for the purpose of accuracy we have not quoted these. Please feel free to obtain information in this regard from our Front Office Team at the hotel.



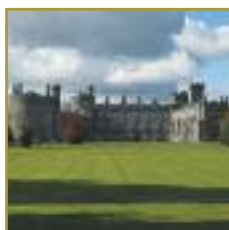
St. Canice's Cathedral

Built between 1202 & 1285 it has been preserved in its original style and form. View the city and surrounding area from the 9th century round tower.



Rothe House

A 16th century Merchants home. Open to the public as a Museum, displaying some of the 2,500 artefacts collected by the Society since its founding in 1947. The Gardens are also open to the public.



Kilkenny Castle

Kilkenny's Medieval 12th century castle is one of the most recognised buildings in Ireland. Set in 1830's splendour with extensive gardens and parkland.



St. Francis Abbey Brewery

Located in the City, on the site of the Franciscan Abbey which was founded in 1231. Commercial brewing started in 1710 and it's Ireland's oldest Brewery. It has just recently opened to guided tours providing a pint of Smithwick's at the end!



Woodstock Gardens

Situated alongside the beautiful village of Inistioge home to the film 'Circle of Friends' from the Maeve Binchy Book. Woodstock Gardens date back from 1740 and offer over 4 miles of footpath. The Monkey Puzzle walk is the largest and most mature avenue recorded in Europe.



Kilfane Glen & Waterfall

A pristine example of a romantic era garden dating from the 1790s. Untouched for 200 years, it is a picturesque paradise with a waterfall tumbling its way to a rushing stream and woodland paths leading to a cottage orné. Tiny bridges sit among ancient trees, wild foxgloves, ferns and other historically correct 18th century planting.



Castlecomer Discovery Park

Originally part of the Demense of the 17th century Castlecomer House. The park includes 6km of woodland walking trails complete with picnic areas and two rainbow trout angling lakes. At the heart of the park is the visitor centre with its exhibition 'Footprints in Coal' which explores the complete story of the Castlecomer coal from formation to extraction.



Craft Trail

See at first hand some of Ireland's finest crafts people at work. Visit among many others: Rudolf Heltzel situated in the City to Chesneau Leather, Nicholas Mosse Pottery and Moth to a Flame located in the quaint village of Bennetsbridge. Close by just outside Thomastown you will also find Jerpoint Glass. We are happy to advise you of the complete listing upon request.



Wexford Opera House

A specifically commissioned state-of-the-art opera house and home to the world-famous Wexford Festival Opera. And with the new roads you will make it there and back in no time!



George Bernard Shaw Theatre, Carlow
